

Treatment

Has been recommended to be 84 days regardless of individual cat response and blood testing throughout treatment.

84 days was advised in various documents by Dr Niels Pedersen because this is the period at which the least number of relapses were seen when some studies using illegal blackmarket medications or unknown active ingredient ie dosage were used.

There has also been information alluded to about 84 days being the life of macrophages (cells FIP engulfs.) We are yet to find scientific evidence of this for FIP cats.

If cats present very well and their blood test results confirm this by being back within normal ranges, along with an Alpha-1-acid glycoprotein (AGP) test to confirm there is no lingering FIP inflammation, why would a cat continue to take antivirals which have potentially unknown longterm health consequences for no specific reason?
