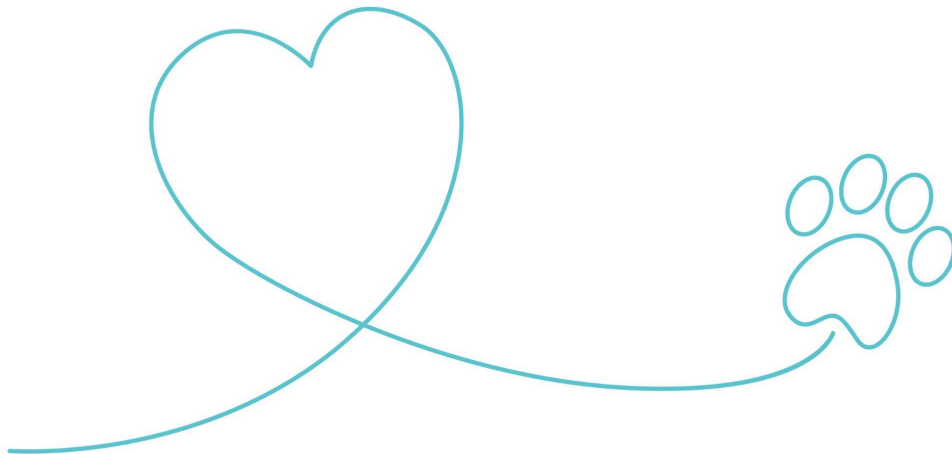

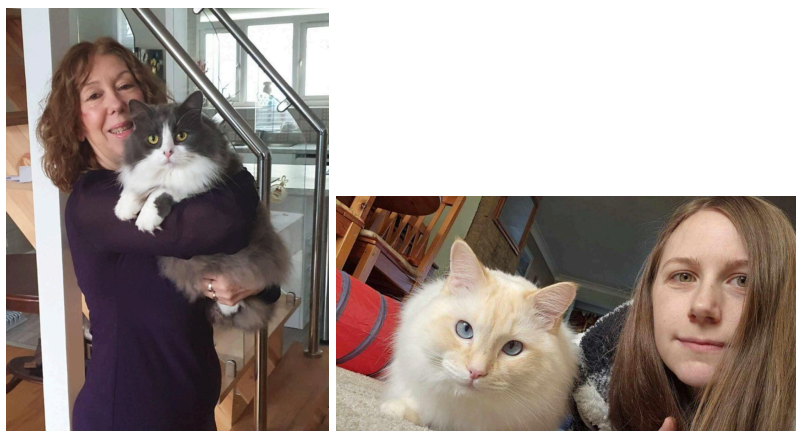
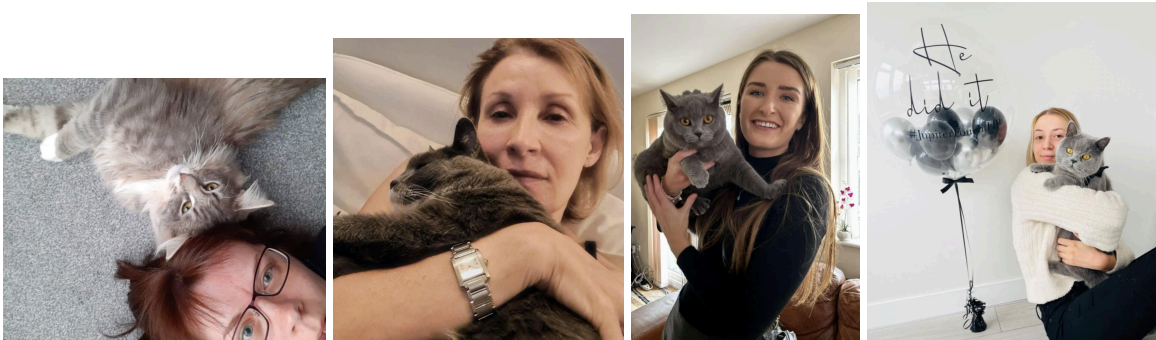

A Little History

FIP was a death sentence for cats prior to legal Vet medication in the UK in summer 2021. It was very expensive prior to March 2023.

Owners were treating cats for 84 days and the dose was weight dependent. A goal of treatment is weight gain as FIP is a disease of starvation. The more weight gained, the more successful the treatment but with this brought owners huge expenses.

Owners were paying (due to unregulated Vet markups) between £45 and £90 per pill across the UK initially in 2021/2022. This was in addition to many thousands of pounds spent on testing trying to get a diagnosis. There is no single test for FIP - it is a process of excluding other differentials and building suspicion.

In March 2023 the sole manufacturing pharmaceutical more than halved their prices of medication to Vets. There was also a second UK manufacturing pharmaceutical. The cheapest pills from Vets were £20-£30 each but most Vets were still charging previous prices and/or continuing to markup throughout 2023 and 2024.

In Autumn 2024 the Vet treatment protocol was updated to higher doses and potential shorter treatment periods for some of 42 days (half of what had been the rule.) The emergence of a tailored treatment plan for individual cats based on their response was in sight and had been long overdue.

Barriers to FIP treatment throughout 2024 and into 2025 continued to be unregulated Veterinary markups and the lack of knowledge and misinformation about the recent protocol update within the profession.

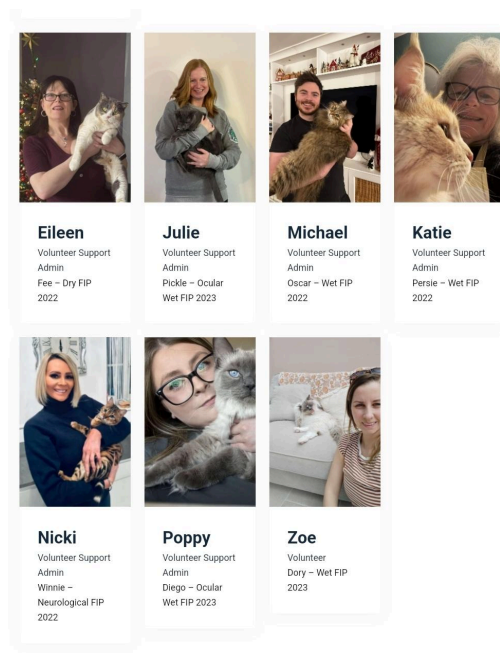
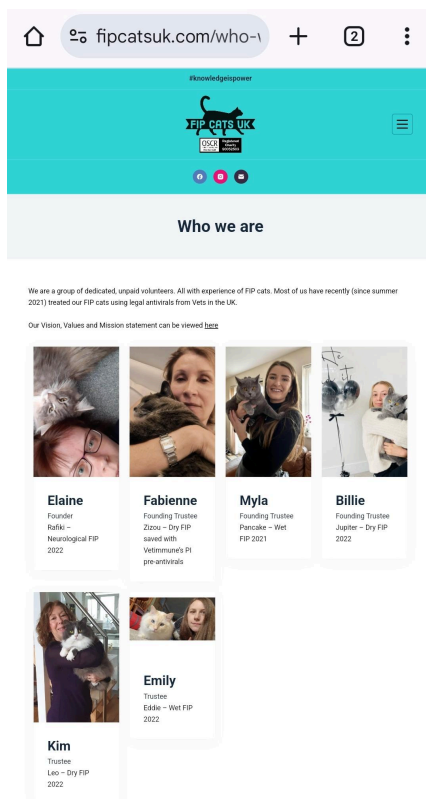

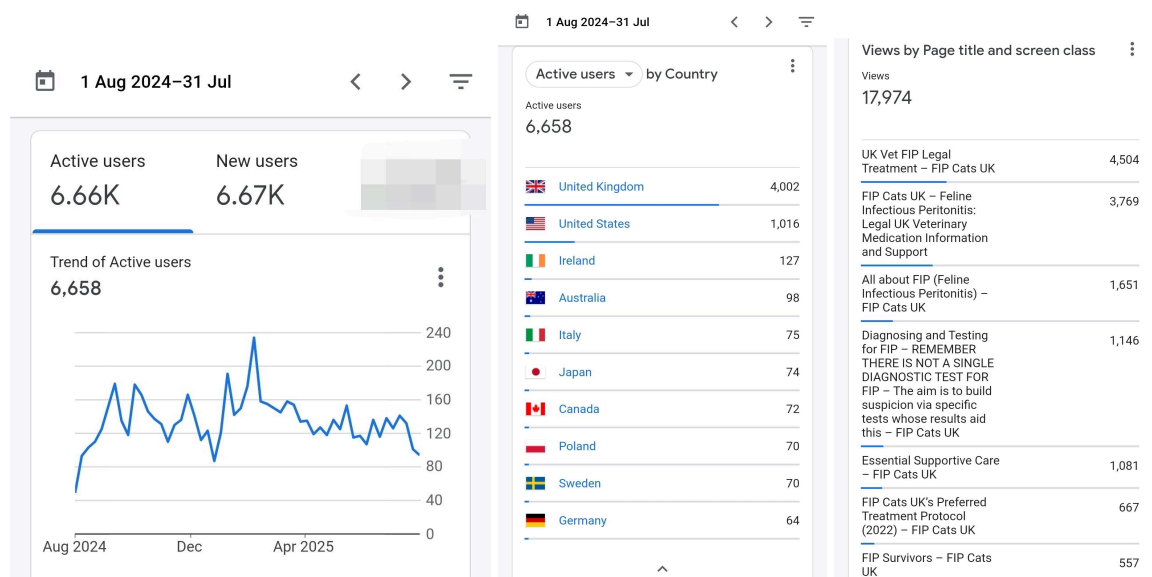

FIP Cats UK has an operational geographic reach that extends beyond its Scottish base with volunteers virtually supporting owners across the UK.

The ongoing visit statistics to our website and social media pages provide insight into our regular worldwide reach.

Our impact is worldwide but UK FIP cats remain our focus.



We provided **virtual support** to owners facing FIP as a diagnosis for their cat's health challenges.

We also provided a group chat to owners offering an inclusive and non-judgemental space to chat with cat owners about their FIP experiences, ask questions and seek reassurance.

FIP Cats UK continued to average several contacts per week for direct assistance in FIP diagnosis to empower the owner to educate their Vet, enquiries about Vet treatment (eg protocol, costs etc) and many others about FIP prevention and queries about cats (who thankfully ended up not having FIP.)

We also, thankfully, saw an increase in contacts from FIP Survivor cat owners seeking information on regular cat health issues and topics - proving these magnificent pets have gone on to live normal, happy lives!

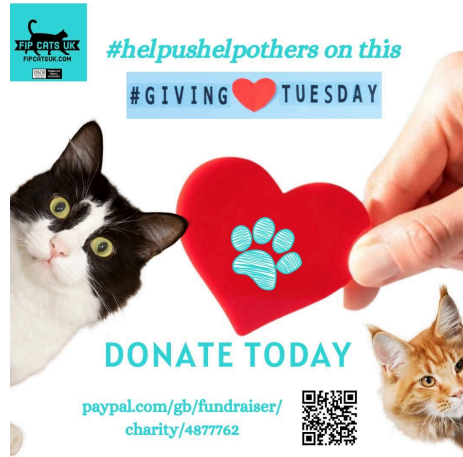

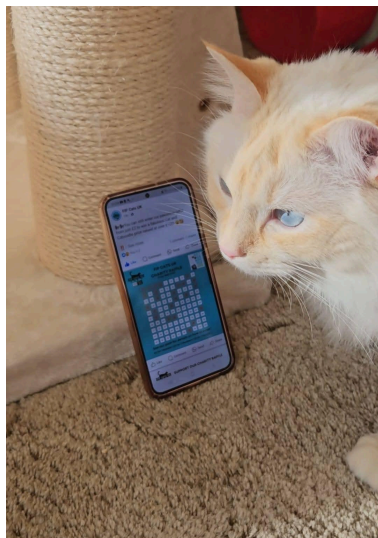

- FIP is now treated with antiviral drugs as Remdesivir (VY) + GS-441524 (balixavir oral suspension) and BUD-1011 (balixavir).
- The treatment duration is now 42 days.
- All forms of FIP (non-effusive (dry) FIP, ocular, neurological and effusive) can be effectively treated with antiviral drugs.
- A legal and affordable feline infectious peritonitis (FIP) treatment is available exclusively through veterinarians.

Rafiki was diagnosed in Glasgow University Small Animal Hospital in January 2022. He was unable to stand or move normally. After 14 days in hospital and a total of 84 days treatment then 84 days observation, Rafiki won his brave battle by using legal UK Vet FIP treatment.

From a very sick young kitten of only a few months of age, to a fully grown three year old, Rafiki is a miracle and a guiding light.

FIP Cats UK provides freely accessible information to all cat owners about legal UK Vet FIP treatment and FIP cat success stories.

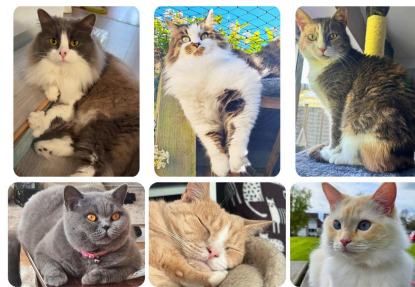

Vets can easily access treatment from Bova and Summit. Treatment is the cheapest it has ever been from the pharmaceuticals (before unnecessary vet head office markups!)

!!!We are aware from some owners that 1 x 30ml of vet GS oral drops can cost £200-£250. For a neurological FIP (highest dose required) kitten of 2kg (and gaining weight) the whole (potential 42 day course) could be less than **£1000**!!!!

"Treatment trial? As effective antiviral treatments for FIP (especially GS441524) are increasingly available, a treatment trial can be instigated if FIP is thought to be very likely. Ideally, appropriate samples will have been collected & submitted for FCoV detection before treatment is started to either confirm a diagnosis of FIP or show that it is very unlikely. During a treatment trial it is important to use objective measures to monitor the response (e.g. weight, temperature, AG ratio). If the cat does not respond rapidly (within a week) to trial treatment using an antiviral of known quality, it is important to consider other diagnoses (for differential diagnoses of FIP, see last page of this tool)."

"Note: Always look for signs of disease elsewhere e.g. in the chest & abdomen via ultrasonography in cats with neurological signs as these areas can be easier & more cost-effective (compared to CT, MRI, CSF collection etc.) to sample to help you diagnostically, even if only neurological signs are apparent."

"Supportive treatment is extremely important and can include appetite stimulants, nutrition, fluid therapy, effusion drainage (e.g. thoracocentesis if dyspnoeic), analgesics, anti-emetic and anti-pyretic drugs."

"Uroliths of GS-441524... It may be prudent, when using high dosages of antivirals, to increase water intake and investigate any urinary signs that develop. Urine can be assessed for crystals that could represent GS-441524."

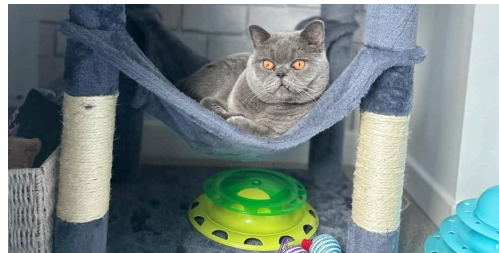

Structure, governance and management

Trust Deed

Trustee recruitment and appointment

During this past year, two new trustees were recruited in the Autumn in addition to the established founding trustees. Both of the new trustees have been given roles to increase the charity's physical attendance at events eg cat shows and to increase fundraising projects.

Our recruitment process:

“The Trustees shall be entitled, by way of a resolution passed by majority vote at a trustees’ meeting, to appoint any individual as a Trustee.

The Trustees shall have power to remove any individual as a Trustee, by way of a resolution passed at a trustees’ meeting, providing two thirds or more of the Trustees then in office vote in favour of the resolution.

An individual holding office as a Trustee may retire by giving notice to that effect (either in writing or by email) to the secretary to the Trust.”



Financial review

Statement of the charity's policy on reserves:

FIP Cats UK Reserves Policy

1. Introduction

FIP Cats UK is a charitable organisation committed to raising awareness, supporting research, and providing financial assistance to owners of cats with suspected or diagnosed Feline Infectious Peritonitis (FIP). Our work directly benefits cats and their owners working towards our vision, values and mission found here

Funding for the charity comes from a mix of public donations and fundraising events. These can vary in size and frequency, depending on public support.

The reserves policy is designed to ensure that FIP Cats UK remains financially sustainable and capable of fulfilling its charitable objectives, even in the face of unexpected expenses.

2. Rationale Behind the Reserves Policy

The trustees of FIP Cats UK believe it is necessary to maintain reserves to:

Ensure continuity of services: FIP Cats UK needs to remain operational even if there are unexpected increases in demand for support. This includes ongoing financial support to owners.

Address unforeseen emergencies: The charity may face sudden and unforeseen events such as a significant drop in donations or sudden increases in requests for assistance.

3. Steps Taken to Establish the Level of Reserves

The trustees have considered the following factors when determining the appropriate level of reserves:



Operational costs: An analysis of day-to-day running costs, including staff, administrative expenses, and costs associated with delivering charitable services, has been conducted - these are personally funded by trustees (excluding insurance) to ensure public donations are used for the reasons outlined in our vision, values and mission.

Future commitments: The charity has ongoing commitments to financial support for future owners of FIP-diagnosed cats. Reserves will ensure that these commitments can be met even if future income is uncertain.

Income uncertainty: FIP Cats UK relies on donations which are irregular and not guaranteed. A reserve is necessary to cover periods of reduced donations.

Risk assessment: Trustees have assessed potential risks such as complete loss of donations or unexpected increases in demand for services, and factored these into the reserve calculations.

4. Level of Reserves Required

The trustees have determined that FIP Cats UK should aim to hold reserves equivalent to emergency initial vet FIP testing and treatment for 2 individual cats.

This is based on the charity's current financial position, donation estimates and identified risks.

The specific target for reserves is set at £2000 which covers critical costs and ongoing commitments for a short-term period of income loss or increased demand.

5. Review and Monitoring of the Reserves Policy

The reserves policy will be reviewed annually by the board of trustees, or sooner if there is a significant change in the charity's financial position. The level of reserves will be monitored regularly to ensure the charity is holding the appropriate amount.



The charity will report on the reserves position annually in its financial statements, detailing the amount held and explaining any significant changes or deviations from the target.

This policy ensures that FIP Cats UK is prepared for financial challenges, supports its beneficiaries, and remains sustainable while achieving its charitable objectives.

By having a clear reserves policy in place, FIP Cats UK demonstrates responsible financial management and reassures donors, funders, and beneficiaries that it is well-positioned to continue its vital work in the face of uncertainty.

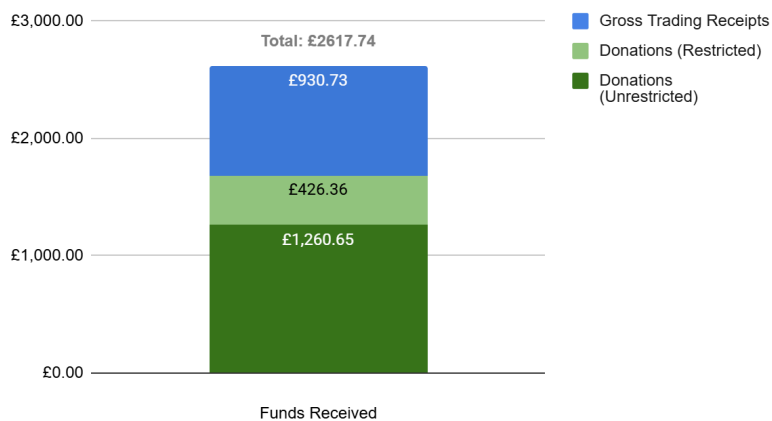

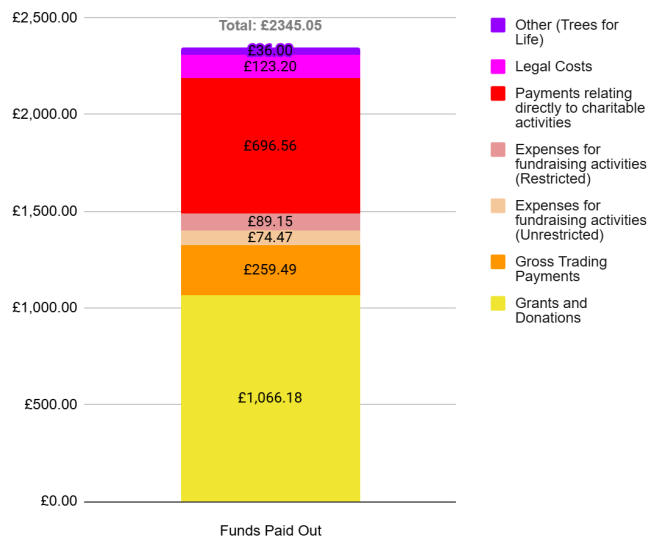
